We are Kauai's first emergency pet friendly disaster shelter to protect our families in the event of another storm like Hurricane Iniki.

We provide animal management services for the County of Kauai to maintain harmony with animals in our neighborhoods.



We protect all animals on Kauai and investigate any report of animal abuse or neglect.

We advocate for animals by promoting effective legislation.

We promote *adopt, don't shop* and offer a wide variety of healthy and well adjusted pets for adoption.

We welcome kids of all ages to learn about animals in our Critter Camps and service learning programs.

We provide free pet spay/neuter services for families in need and for caring feral cat caregivers.
